

Accessing CMH Crisis Services

During Business Hours (8am-5pm M-F, excluding holidays):

- Contact your local CMH office or walk in and ask to speak with a crisis worker
- Your situation will be triaged over the phone by a crisis worker
- You may be asked to respond to the local emergency department

After Business Hours (5pm-8am M-F, weekends, holidays):

- After hours, there are a variety of options for crisis services. Depending on severity,
 - o Call the local CMH crisis number (see below)
 - o Go to the Emergency Room
 - o Call 911
