PROCEDURES

Smoking shall be prohibited in all enclosed facilities within a place of employment without exception. This includes common work areas, auditoriums, classrooms, conference and meeting rooms, private offices, elevators, hallways, medical facilities, cafeterias, employee lounges, stairs, restrooms, vehicles and all other enclosed facilities.

Smoking may occur at a distance of 20 feet outside any enclosed area where smoking is prohibited to ensure that tobacco smoke does not enter the area through entrances, windows, ventilation systems or any other means.

Signs shall be posted at the entryway of every public place indicating either that smoking is prohibited or that smoking is prohibited except in designated areas.
