



What is NorthCare Network Substance Use Disorder Services?

NorthCare Network Substance Use Disorder Services is committed to assisting residents of the Upper Peninsula in obtaining substance use disorder services.

Alcohol and chemical dependency is recognized as a primary, chronic, and progressive disease that can be successfully treated with appropriate identification and treatment.

NorthCare Network's role is to assess the appropriate level of care needed, recommend treatment services, and refer the individual to a participating Substance Use Disorder Provider.

How Will I Pay For Treatment?



Clients are also assessed for funding based on their income, place of residence, and clinical need. People who meet the requirements or are eligible for Medicaid can receive funding for substance use disorder services in the appropriate treatment setting. When scheduling an appointment with an outpatient substance use disorder provider, ask if you are eligible for financial assistance through NorthCare Network.


How Would I Know If I Have A Substance Use Disorder?

Have you ever had memory problems or couldn't remember what you said or did the day after drinking or using drugs?

Have your family or friends told you that they were concerned about your drug use or your drinking?

Have you not followed through with things because of drug or alcohol use?

Have you become sick, had the shakes, or had any withdrawal symptoms the day after using drugs or alcohol?
